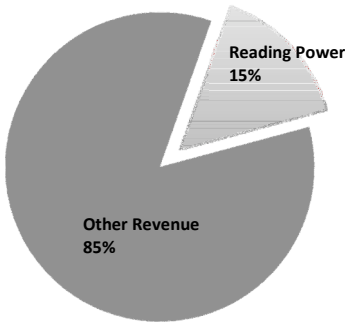


Reading Power Read-a-Thon

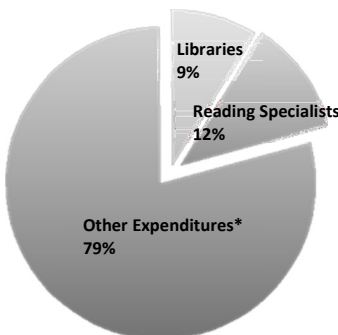
